- Use GALILEO to access an article titled "Persistent Anomaly Changes in High-Resolution Climate Simulations"

2. Chapter from a book or edited collection (*give reference entry for both chapters*)

- Use GALILEO to **first access the eBook** and then locate the identified "Chapter"
 - Chapter 15: "Design without a Designer?" from *Universe in Creation: A New Understanding of the Big Bang and the Emergence of Life*.
 - Chapter 21: "The Grounded Theory Method and Humanistic Psychology" from *The Handbook of Humanistic Psychology: Theory, Research, and Practice*.
